

# Safe Supply of plant



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**Your expectation should be**

- ✓ Pre hire inspected
- ✓ Serviced and maintained with regard to OEM and standards
- ✓ Documentation supplied to enable hiree to meet their obligation
  - Operation and safety instruction
  - Evidence plant has been inspected before hire
  - Evidence of service and maintenance
  - Some form of risk assessment (dependant on plant)



# Coates Hire Plant Risk Strategy

- ☐ **Low Risk** – Plant with **basic operation** and/or **potential for minor personal injury or insignificant property damage** e.g. hand tools, furniture, etc
- ☐ **Medium Risk** - Plant with **less complex operation** but with **potential for serious personal injury or minimal property damage** e.g. generators, air compressors, pumps, electric tools etc
- ☐ **High Risk Small Plant** - Plant associated with **High Risk Activities** e.g. **exposure to moving parts, high pressure, working at height** etc. e.g. chainsaws, demo saws etc
- ☐ **High Risk Mobile Powered** - Plant with **complex operation** and/or **potential for serious personal injury or substantial property damage**. e.g. earthmoving equipment, EWP's, telehandlers etc

# Safety Commissioner of Australia (FSC)

- In 2009 the Federal Safety Commissioner of Australia (FSC) introduced an accreditation Scheme that required Construction Companies to be accredited if the value of the job exceeded \$3 M
  - Design
  - Delivery/Transport/Commissioning
  - Operation
  - Maintenance
- Initial inconsistency from auditors (FSC) resulting in varied interpretations of requirements from construction companies
